- 2. Summer Camp (June 9-15)- a \$100 deposit for attending Scouts and \$125 fee for attending adults is <u>due no later than February 24</u>, or Nicole will not be able to sign your scout up for summer camp classes in early March
  - a. You can pay by CHECK or CASH ONLY NO VENMO!
  - Place your check or cash in an envelope marked with your Scout's Name,
    Parent's name if attending, dollar amount and what the money's for (Ex.
    Summer Camp Deposit)
  - c. Please bring your money to the February 4 Blue & Gold/Crossover Ceremony, February 11 troop meeting, February 17 Flag Retirement event OR the February 24 USI MBU.
  - d. NO DEPOSIT, NO CLASS SIGN UP
  - e. Any adult attending summer camp needs to fill out an application with the troop and complete Youth Protection Training **BEFORE May 1.**
  - f. It is best to get this done as early as possible since the information has to be turned into Buffalo Trace Council, so come to a troop meeting and get help from any committee member who may be present.
  - g. Camp Class options should be available soon. We'll get that information to you as soon as it becomes available.

#### 3. Recharter

a. Committee (Brent & Tine) will review the roster of who will need to be removed from our Troop list before we pay recharter fees.

#### 4. Individual accounts for each Scout

- a. Take fundraiser profit and split with participating scouts
- b. Money shared with Scout would be based on hours each scout works
- c. The treasurer will place this on Scoutbook so each family can view their balance
- d. Committee has agreed upon a 70/30 split of fundraiser profit
- e. More detailed information will be provided to families at a later date

#### 5. Attendance Reminder

- a. <u>Beginning January 2024</u>: Each scout must attend at least 50% of all meetings AND activities/fundraisers to be considered an active member of the troop.
- b. All scouts are responsible to sign in at every meeting and activity they attend so that the committee can keep track of how involved each scout is in our troop.
- c. If a scout does not meet the requirements in the 2024 scouting year, then at the time of recharter in February 2025, that scout family will be responsible for paying the full recharter fee, if that scout would like to continue in our troop. (As of 2024, that amount is \$80)

#### 6. Sts Peter & Paul Auction donation from our Troop

- a. Since Sts. Peter & Paul is a charter organization, we as a troop plan to make 3 wooden flags to donate to their auction in April.
